This training is for anyone who needs to become a Certified Food Safety Manager. In the City of Philadelphia, a certified staff person must be present whenever food is being prepared or served in a licensed facility. In addition to successfully completing this national certification exam, Philadelphia workers must register with the Philadelphia Department of Public Health; information will be provided as part of the training. If you were previously certified, but your certificate is expiring, you **MUST** retake the class, as well as the exam. You can no longer do just the exam; there are no more “short” recertification classes.

This is a fast-track training, in one day (we used to do two!), but it requires that you get and read the text in advance – 8 hours home study is expected. When you register we will send the book to you: you must have a valid address, or you may make arrangements to pick up the book (W. Philly or Center City). You *must* also have a working email account to register for the exam. The exam, at the end of the day, is multiple-choice questions; the passing grade is 75%. As a national exam, this certification is accepted in all states and by all health departments. Results usually come back in 7-10 days. The next training will be in November.

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
